PASSING OUT PARADE OF CONST(FIRE)

A ceremonial parade was held on 13th May, 2000 on the occasion of passing out parade of the 11th batch of Constable/Fire at Fire Service Training Institute at NISA Complex. A total of 180 Firemen successfully completed a 40 week rigorous training schedule which included 2 separate modules on industrial security and Fire training. The parade comprising these 180 Fire safety professionals was reviewed by Shri Ch.Vidyasagar Rao, Hon'ble Minister of State for Home Affairs. Speaking on the occasion, Shri Rao lauded the role of CISF as a unique Armed Force of the union in discharging wide ranging responsibilities extending from Industrial, Internal and Aviation Security to Corporate Consultancy and International Peacekeeping. He emphasized the role of security forces in combating fire disasters

and expressed the hope that the firemen passing out will take upon themselves to guard the national wealth from fire disasters. Dr. Trinath Mishra, Director General, CISF also participated in the programme.

In his address Shri P.V.K. Reddy, IPS, DIG, NISA emphasized on the role of NISA as the training ground, a "Karmabhoomi" in moulding raw talent into dedicated firemen. He said that while professional excellence is the basic and primary objective of our endeavours, considerable emphasis has been given in the Academy on character building and integrated personality development besides helping trainees to build positive attitude towards work and fellow human beings. He called upon the trainees passing out that day to cultivate public spirit, commercial integrity, individual rectitude and peaceful behaviour.

FOUNDATION STONE FOR RESIDENTIAL COMPLEX

Foundation Stone for construction of 48 family quarters of Fire Services Training Institute (Type I-VI) was laid by Shri Ch.Vidhyasagar Rao, Hon'ble Ministr of State for Home on 13th May, 2000 in the presence of Dr.Trinath Mishra,DG, CISF, Shri P.V.K.Reddy,DIG, NISA and other senior officials of CPWD and NISA. These are to be constructed at a cost of Rs.222.52 lakhs to accommodate the families of FSTI Staff.

RAIN HARVESTING MEASURES

The Academy implemented its Action Plan on Rain Water Harvesting for the year 2000, a remarkable achievement in creating awareness about environmental protection among staff and trainees. As per the plan, 27 structures have been constructed entirely through 'Shramdan' which include 5 contour trenches, 9 percolation pits and 13 bunds, designed to prevent wasteful outflow and facilitate conservation of rain water. With this relentless and ardent effort of the Academy, the volume of rain water that can be

harvested in NISA campus is estimated at 35,612,36 cu.metres approximately which in turn will contribute to the annual recharge of water and in raising of under ground water level.
