FIRE SERVICE DAY

A Commemoration Parade was organized on 14th April on the occasion of "Fire Service Day" which is also observed as "Martyr's Day" to pay homage to those brave fire fighters who laid down their lives on 14th April 1944 in the Mumbai Dock Explosion which swallowed 66 gallant Officers, 89 firemen and 700 other people. Director/NISA laid the wreath at "SHAHID SMARAK" during the solemn ceremony organized to mark the supreme sacrifice by the fireman.

In his address Shri P.V.K.Reddy, IPS, Director NISA said that we also pay homage to those brave fire fighters who laid down their lives on 11 September 2001 while fighting fire and rescuing the trapped persons inside the World Trade Centre in USA.

The CISF Fire Service constituted in the year 1969, has witnessed a steady growth and today it provides effective fire protection coverage to 83 PSUs in different sectors. On this occasion, the

Director NISA strongly appealed to all fire service personnel to adopt the best possible fire precaution and safety measures and there by contribute in Security Precautions, protecting human lives and national wealth.

SEMINAR ON INDUSTRIAL SECURITY MANAGEMENT

A seminar on Industrial Security Management for Senior Officers of State Police and CPOs was organized for the third time at the Academy from 12.05.2003 to 16.05.2003. Officers of the rank of DIG & Commandant participated. Dr.S.Subramanian, IPS, DGP (Retd.) inaugurated the Seminar on 12.05.2003.
