### VERTICAL INTERACTION COURSE ON DISASTER MANAGEMENT

A Vertical Interaction Course on Disaster Management for IPS Officers was organised at the Academy for the second time from 19<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2001. The six-day programme, sponsored by the Bureau of Police Research & Development, was attended by 23 police officers of various ranks from SP to IG. The course was designed with a view to enable the participants to appreciate various factors and agencies associated with disaster management. Inputs were given on the concepts of disaster management, rescue and relief operations, role of police, media, public, NGOs etc., with special reference to selected case studies of Gujarat Earthquake, Andhra cyclone, Bhopal Gas tragedy and Chernobyl nuclear disaster. Eminent guest speakers from diverse fields were invited and field visits to reputed institutions like National

Geophysical Research Institute, Nuclear Fuel Complex, NIC & Hi-tech City were organised. Syndicate presentations and experience sharing by participants on important dimensions of this multi disciplinary science made the VIC lively and interactive. The course was inaugurated by Dr A V S Reddy, IAS, Principal Secretary (Revenue), Govt of AP and valedicted by Shri B B Nanda, IPS, DG, CISF. In his inaugural address, Dr Reddy stressed upon the need for multi-agency coordination in disaster management. Addressing the participants at the valediction of the course, Shri Nanda dwelt upon the role played by CISF in disaster situations and emphasized that the force had the potential to emerge as the nodal agency for disaster management in the country. He also informed the participants that a comprehensive programme of one month duration on the same theme would be organised at the Academy in the second half of 2001 in which senior functionaries from diverse fields would participate.

**SEMINAR ON INDUSTRIAL SECURITY MANAGEMENT**

A Seminar on Industrial Security Management for senior officers of CPOs & State police was organised for the first time at the Academy from 26.03.2001 to 30.03.2001.

The main objective of the seminar was to facilitate meaningful discussion on the security environment in the country in general and industrial security in particular, to identify emerging threats to industrial security and devise protective strategies to meet the challenges effectively. The major thrust areas of the seminar included Risk Analysis and Vulnerability Assessment, Nuclear Security, Security of Space Installations, Cyber Crimes, Disaster Management, Cost-effectiveness of Industrial Security, Security Training and Profile of Security Chief in the new Millennium.

**FSTI QUARTERS INAUGURATED**

A Family Quarters complex consisting of 51 quarters for FSTI staff was inaugurated by Shri B B Nanda, IPS, DG, CISF on 24.03.2001. The complex was constructed at a cost of Rs.223 lakhs in a record time of 10 months. The completion of family accommodation fulfills a long felt need of FSTI staff. The Fire Service Training Institute of CISF was shifted from Deoli in Rajasthan to NISA complex in October, 1999 with a view to achieving a dynamic synergy of the Security and Fire training wings under one umbrella at the same campus.

Infrastructural development is a major focus of the Institute in order to meet ever-growing professional commitments. Plans are under way for construction of a model fire station equipped with the latest state-of-the-art fire fighting devices.
