DIKSHANT PARADE OF SUB-INSPECTOR/EXE (21ST BATCH)

A ceremonial parade was held on 10th Feb., 2003 at the Academy Parade ground on the occasion of the passing out parade of the 21st Batch of Sub Inspector/Exe. Shri Surjit Singh Barnala, His Excellency, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh reviewed the parade consisting of 8 contingents.

Speaking on the occasion the Chief Guest Shri Barnala said that the NISA upgraded into a National Academy, barely a decade ago is now recognized as a "Centre of Excellence" in Industrial Security Management. He also said that it is heartening to note that Government of India declared NISA in January, 2003 as National Level Institution for training of specialized Search and Rescue/Response teams being constituted at the level of Central Government as well as State Governments in case of disasters.

Shri Barnala also said that on the Aviation Security front, 45 airports in the country have been brought under CISF Security and Delhi Airport's Induction is slated to be in April 2003. Post 13th December attack on Indian Parliament prompted the Government of India to hand over the VIP security gradually to CISF which is otherwise being done by CRPF, ITBP and National Security Guards. He said that he has no doubt that this National Facility will continue to strive for higher levels

of excellence in imparting training so that the trainees will not only bring laurels to CISF but also to our Nation.

After his speech the Chief Guest Shri Barnala presented Police Medals for Meritorious service to 18 Officers/Men and Fire Medal for Meritorious Service to one HC/Fire. He also gave away awards to Sub-Inspector trainees who topped in various disciplines after completing a rigorous training schedule of 52 weeks. The recipients of awards were Shri Alok Sharma, SI/UT who was adjusted 'All Round Best', Y Dilip Kumar Singh, SI/UT 'Best in Out Door', Anirudh Sharma, SI/UT 'Best in Physical Training', N Madhava Rao, SI/UT 'Best in Indoor' and Sanjeev Kumar, SI/UT 'Best in Firing'. The parade was followed by an impressive demonstration in fire rescue operations by the staff of the Fire Service Training Institute (FSTI) located at the NISA Complex.

In his welcome speech Shri P V K Reddy, IPS, Director, NISA said that the mission of NISA is to produce outstanding security professionals. Being an integral part of the security apparatus of the country as a whole CISF as an Armed force has to face the new challenges from elements inimical to the nations unity, integrity and sovereignty. Director, NISA called upon all trainees to cultivate the values of public service, integrity, individual rectitude, peaceful behaviour and to continue to tread on the spiritual path.

NATURAL DISASTER MANAGEMENT COURSE FOR DISTRICT LEVEL OFFICERS

Natural Disaster Management Course for District Level Officers was held at this Academy from 20.01.2003 to 25.01.2003. Shri B B Mishra, IPS, DG, CISF inaugurated the course on 20.01.2003. This was the 3rd course on Natural Disaster Management, sponsored by Ministry of Agriculture. A total of 23 officers took part in the Course.

In his address Shri B B Mishra, IPS, DG, CISF emphasized the importance of Disaster Management in the development of a country and its economy. He also said that lack of infrastructure and capacity and higher vulnerability not only amplify the toll, in terms of both life and material, but also hamper and decelerate recovery process.
