VERTICAL INTERACTION COURSE FOR IPS OFFICER'S

A Vertical Interaction Course of one week on "Disaster Management" for IPS Officers was inaugurated on 24th September, 2001 by Shri Bharath Chandra, IPS, Principal Secretary, Home, Government of Andhra Pradesh at the Academy. The course was sponsored by the Bureau of Police Research & Development. This was the 3rd Vertical Interaction Course being organized at the Academy. In the course 31 Police Officers ranging from the Rank of SP to IG belonging to different State Police Cadres and Central Police Organizations participated.

Speaking on the occasion, Shri Bharath Chandra said that the recent terrorist attack on world Trade Centre and Pentagon in USA had highlighted the disastrous implications of human actions necessitating launching of relief operations on war footing. He further said that in the prevailing internal security scenario in our country, suicide attacks on vital installations cannot be ruled out.

He emphasized that the police and other Law enforcement agencies have to shoulder the responsibility for prevention of terrorist attacks of disastrous implications.

Shri B.B.Nanda, IPS, Director General, CISF valedicted the course on Disaster Management. Speaking on the occasion, Shri Nanda said that there is need for paradigm shift from Post-Disaster Reconstruction and Relief to Pre-Disaster Proactive Approach. Elaborating on the role of CISF during the recent earthquake in Gujarat, Shri Nanda said that CISF has been second to none in providing succour to victims and undertaking spontaneous rescue and relief activities. He also informed the participants that a number of CISF companies worked for relief of the quake victims in Bhuj, Ahmedabad, Mehsana, Kandla and other areas of Gujarat during the disaster. Shri P.V.K.Reddy, IPS, DIG/NISA also emphasized that the role of the Police and Armed Forces is vital in rescue and relief operations which require massive mobilization of manpower at short notice.
