### STUDY TOUR CUM TRAINING FOR IAS OFFICERS OF NORTH EAST REGION

1<sup>st</sup> Study Tour Cum Training for IAS Officers of North East Region was inaugurated on 25.11.2002 by Shri P V K Reddy, IPS, Director, NISA. The Course was sponsored by United Nations Development Programme. 06 Officers took part in this course, which was held from 25.11.2002 to 04.12.2002. The main objectives of the course were to strengthen disaster management capacity, to look at problems pertaining to disaster management in an integrated manner and to develop a holistic approach towards them.

The inputs of the course included visit to cyclone affected areas in Nellore, Kakinada and Vishakhapatnam in Andhra Pradesh. Shri V Thulasidas, IAS, Chief Secretary, Tripura in his valedictory address on 04.12.2002 stressed the need of a vision for Disaster Management through strategic thinking, preparedness, prevention and quick response and to have a mission to raise through collective wisdom, sustained efforts, concern for environment, synergy of State capacity and intensity of peoples' participation. Further, he emphasized on pre disaster preparedness, post disaster operations, contingency plans and building norms and felt that knowledge and skill in handling disasters at various places be compiled and shared by the all concerned agencies. He underlined an institutional framework for a three tier training programme for political executives, officers/workers and community at large, in equipping each state to face any kind of disaster.

### **NATURAL DISASTER MANAGEMENT COURSE FOR DISTRICT LEVEL OFFICERS**
