5th Natural Disaster Management Course for District Level Officers was held at this Academy from 23.02.2004 to 28.02.2004. 29 participants took part in the course which was sponsored by the Ministry of Home Affairs. The course was inaugurated by Shri M.Madhavan Nambiar, IAS, Executive Director, National Institute of Disaster Management, New Delhi.

The aims and objectives of the course were to look at the problems pertaining to Natural Disaster Management in an integrated manner, to develop a holistic approach towards them and to sensitize the participants towards issues of National concern and to make them more responsive to the needs of the people in the event of any disaster.

Some of the inputs of the course included Post Disaster Response, Role of media in Natural Disaster Management, Use of Geographical Information System in Natural Disaster Management, Disaster Management and communication through HAM Radios etc.,

The course focused on delineation of roles of different agencies like Revenue administration, Police and Armed forces, Fire services, Medical services and infrastructural service providers like Public Works Department. The role of NGOs, Media and Community in creating disaster awareness and response mechanism was discussed in great detail.

To meet the course objectives, the participants were provided with inputs in areas of crisis and disaster management, training and development of personnel, leadership and motivation, decision making and its application,

handling court cases, information technology, as well as issues of personal concern like stress management and grievance redressal. In addition, their skills in weapons handling were refreshed.

On this occasion the Director expressed his conviction that PPC for Senior Commandant to DIG is a step in the right direction as senior officers of the Force will have time to discuss and deliberate upon the issues confronting the CISF, besides, refreshing and re-consolidating their professional knowledge in different spheres of CISF.

TOT ON RESPONSE TO NUCLEAR & RADIOLOGICAL DISASTERS

A TOT on response to Nuclear & Radiological disasters was held at this Academy from 23.02.2004 to 11.03.2004, which was organized by BARC. Shri P.V.K.Reddy, IPS, Director, NISA, inaugurated the course on 23.02.2004.

In his inaugural address Shri Reddy welcomed Shri M.S.Kale, Scientific Officer, Scientists of BARC, the participants and the members of the faculty and said that this is the first course of its kind conducted at this Academy. Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) such as nuclear biological and chemical, in the possession of hostile countries and terrorists, represent one of the greatest security challenges facing the world.

He expressed that if we forget history we are condemned to repeat it. He further expressed that we should learn lessons from the Hiroshima and Nagasaki bombings as well as Chernobyl accidents involving nuclear materials. The threats from radiological material and 'dirty bombs' are an impending reality.

He wished that the faculty of Department of Atomic Energy who are experts in the field of radiation protection and medical management of radiation injuries would impart training to the NISA faculty to become effective trainers who in turn would train the first responders to respond in case of nuclear disaster and fulfill the objectives of the course.
