7th NATURAL DISASTER MANAGEMENT COURSE

A course on Natural Disaster Management for District Level Officers was organised at NISA from 24th - 29th January 2005. 31 officers attended the course from various parts of the country. Shri P. V. K. Reddy, IPS, Director, NISA, Hyderabad inaugurated the course.

In the welcome address Shri P. V. K. Reddy IPS, Director, NISA, said that the world is witnessing an increasing number of disasters be they natural or man made. While there were around 2800 natural disasters in the decade 1990 – 2000 the four years of this decade i.e. 2000-2004 have already witnessed 1800 natural disasters.

The recent devastation due to the tsunami in many districts of coastal India as well as in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands has again demonstrated the vulnerability of our nation to various disasters. Not only are we vulnerable to events or incidents within our territory, but incidents which occur thousands of kilometers away have their repercussions on our people as was witnessed during the recent tsunami.

This integrated and interactive course on Natural Disaster Management for District Level Officers was being organised to sensitize the participants on the various aspects of natural disasters and to help devise strategies to mitigate their effects. He concluded that this course will also provide a forum for lively discussions as to how we should concretize mechanisms for a cohesive response by different agencies.

Rear Admiral V. Balachandran, AVSM, VSM, NM, Commandant, College of Defence Management, Hyderabad valedicted the course on 29th January, 2005.
