TENTH NATURAL DISASTER MANAGEMENT COURSE FOR DISTRICT LEVEL OFFICERS

The tenth Natural Disaster Management Course for District Level Officers was conducted at this Academy from 17.07.06 to 22.07.06. Fifteen officers attended this course out of which six were from different Central Police Organisations.

Shri Debabrata Kantha, IAS, Commissioner Disaster Management, Ex – officio Secretary to the Government of Andhra Pradesh, inaugurated the course.

The objectives of the course were a) introduction of different kinds of disasters to the participants with emphasis on typical problems associated with each disaster b) sensitizing the participants towards the efforts and the perspectives of the government and non government agencies engaged in this field and c) making the participants more responsive to the needs of the people affected by disaster at District level.

During this course valuable inputs were provided in the form of emerging concepts on Disaster Management, Disaster Prevention, Sustainable development, multi-agency coordination, contingency planning, rescue and relief

operations, information management and application of engineering in Disaster Management.

INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE

The sixtieth Independence Day celebration was held at the Academy on 15th August. Director NISA hoisted the National flag at the Academy Parade ground and reviewed the parade.
